(Spanish backing track plays **CD 17** as Spanish children exit stage - fade appropriately. Hawaiian children enter.)

Hawaiian 1 Aloha from Hawaii, the land of sand and sea, If you lived in Hawaii you'd have to dance like me.

SONG 2 HAWAIIAN SONG. CD tracks 4/19 (Hawaiian children sing and dance appropriately.)

Hawaiian 2 Now Bethlehem was busy, there was no place to stay. So in a stable Christ was born, and in a manger lay.

Hawaiian 3 For Jesus Christ God's only Son was born upon this night, To shine upon this world and change our darkness into light.

Hawaiian 4 Merry Christmas from Hawaii.

(Indian backing track plays **CD 21** as Indian children exit stage - fade appropriately. American children enter.)

American 1 We are from the U.S.A. We bring you greetings here today. From every state we bring our love, giving thanks to God above.

Our country has variety, land of the brave and home of the free.

SONG 4 AMERICAN SONG. CD tracks 8/23 (American children sing and line dance.)

American 2 With in a clear and starlit sky, one star shone extra bright, Guiding three kings from Eastern lands, to worship him that night.

American 3 We wish you a 'Merry Christmas and a happy new Year'.

Americans How 'r ya doin, ya all?

(American backing track plays **CD 23** as American children exit stage - fade appropriately. Chinese children enter stage.)

Chinese 3 From China we wish you a Merry Christmas

(Chinese backing track plays **CD 25** as Chinese children exit stage - fade appropriately. African children enter.)

African 1 We come from Africa, where the lion and elephant roam.

With tropical forrests, deserts and rivers, this beautiful land is our home.
